Neer Garh Water Fall:

About a mile and a half NE from the Laxman Jhula Bridge in Rishikesh lies one of the best natural escapes around. A series of three stunning waterfalls make up the Neer Garh falls. Once you are by the stream, there is a small pool at the bottom that you can dip your feet in or even sit at a table in and drink some chai. From here you will follow the stairs up the mountain and along the stream to cross the first bridge. The trail keeps going up and gets gradually steeper, but when you see the two lower tiers of waterfalls from the trail, you can veer off the trail to get a closer look and also a more intimate photographic opportunity.



Beatles Ashram:

The Maharishi's International Academy of Meditation, also called the Chaurasi Kutia Ashram, is a 14-acre (57,000 m²) compound surrounded by jungle, set across the Ganges from the town, and 150 feet (46 m) above the river. Beatles spent some time learning meditation here in 1968 and composed a few famous songs.



Ram Jhula:

Ram Jhula is an iron suspension bridge across the river Ganges, located 3 kilometres (1.9 mi) north-east from the town Rishikesh in the Indian state of Uttarakhand. The bridge connects the Sivananda Nagar area of Muni Ki Reti in Tehri Garhwal district to Swargashram in Pauri Garhwal district crossing the river from west to east. Built in the year 1986, the bridge is one of the iconic landmarks of Rishikesh.



Ganga Aarti:

The sunset Ganga Aarti at Parmarth Niketan draws between hundreds and thousands of visitors each day from all cultures, all languages, all religions and all walks of life. Regardless of one's religion or ability to understand Hindi or Sanskrit, the power of the aarti is universal. Ganga Aarti transcends the borders and boundaries of language and culture, diving straight into one's heart, carrying one to Heaven. Ganga Aarti begins every day at sunset (times vary depending on season, please check with reception for daily timings) at Parmarth's Ganga Ghat. Yagna begins at the ghat a half hour before Aarti.

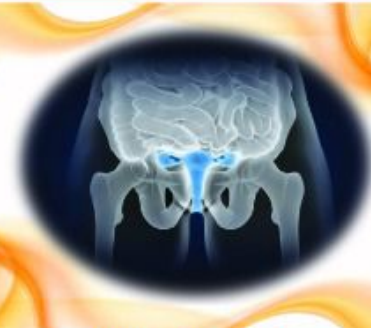
